#### **Foraging Update**

County Supervisor Steven Shea attended our last Friends of Grant Park meeting to hear our group's opposition. Friends of Grant Park and others voiced opposition to allowing foraging in the parks at the last County board meeting of the Parks, Energy & Environment committee. FOGP members will circulate petitions that support the Friends of Grant Park position opposing Milwaukee County Ordinance Amendment 47.08.

#### **Bucyrus Foundation 2022 Grant to City of South Milwaukee**

The grant is \$10 million over 10 years. Deb Pizur emailed South Milwaukee Mayor Brooks to ask that our projects be considered for a portion of the funding and the mayor assured her that we would be. We need a project that is ready for any timeline the Bucyrus Foundation may present. Getting initial input from Unit Coordinator Sean Kelly, Natural Areas Coordinator Brian Russart, or County Executive David Crowley and putting forth projects at different cost levels are good ideas. We may want to ask for funding of current programming such as Suburban Soles.

Proposal to Combine 2022 SM Historical Society's Garden Tour with FoGP Art Fair at Wil-o-Way This will be discussed at the next meeting.

#### **FoGP Calendar Update**
